4. Appropriate resources are obtained to allow individuals to carry out health and safety functions.
5. Maintained facilities and environments in which individuals carry out Lotus Bridge International School's work, study, or research.
6. Comprehensive insurance coverage (Medical, Workplace & Public Liability) provides additional support to staff in, Health and Safety. Work-Life Balance Policy, Work from Home and flexible working arrangement is provided to staff when required.
7. LBIS values the health, safety and security of our stakeholders and community. LBIS is committed to mitigate risks.
8. LBIS promotes effective two-way communication and consultation with staff, students, and visitors at all levels and functions in the development, planning, implementation, performance evaluation, and actions for improvement of the Health and Safety management system.
